This year UNC will see a new and improved Carolina Union Activities Board (CUAB). With its diverse and entertaining field of programs and plans for 1991, CUAB functions should be an integral part of student life.

CUAB consists of approximately 13 committees (chosen by the CUAB president), each formed to focus on the different parts and aspects of student interest.

Unlike the past years, CUAB committees this year will be a bit more overlapping in duties and

focus so that not a single student will have an excuse not to get involved. The 13 committees are as follows:

Gallery deals with art exhibits in the Carolina Union Gallery and in the glass showcases also in the Carolina Union. The art displayed here usually ranges from student to local theme art, with such exhibits as AIDS awareness and a recent textile ensemble.

Film brings all of the latest movies to the Union Auditorium. Check the Union front desk for showtime schedules!

Forum brings in prominent speakers and experts in their fields from all over the country. Past

speakers include Louis Farrakhan, Robert Townsend, Maya Angelou and Spike Lee.

Theatre Arts, Social Adventures and Performing Arts share the focus on student entertainment and talent with programs such as live bands, dances and theatre. Last year, CUAB's Performing Arts series included performances such as Sarafina, the Harlem Boys Club and the Chicago Dance Theatre. **Performing Arts Outreach**, is the support group and sometimes the selection group of the Performing Arts Series.

Current Issues, brings a creative approach to important

social issues instead of traditional speakers and lecturers. In the past this committee has confronted the problem of date rape with a "Mock Date Rape Trial." Current Issues has also showed viewings of Spike Lee's "Do The Right Thing," with discussion sessions afterward.

College Bowl is a Jeopardy-type trivia tournament which fields over 40 teams at UNC. Winners of UNC's tournament gain an automatic bid to the Association to College Unions International Tournament.

Concert Advisory is in charge of finding concerts, outdoor music events and acts for UNC students.

Special Projects is a more

flexible committee in that it can chose and give a more intense drive toward the issue or plans of the consensual committee feeling.

Advertising and Public Relations aim to be the liaison with other parts of the university. They keep an "ear to the ground" to see what people want and don't get enough of. These two committees relate with all on-campus organizations.
