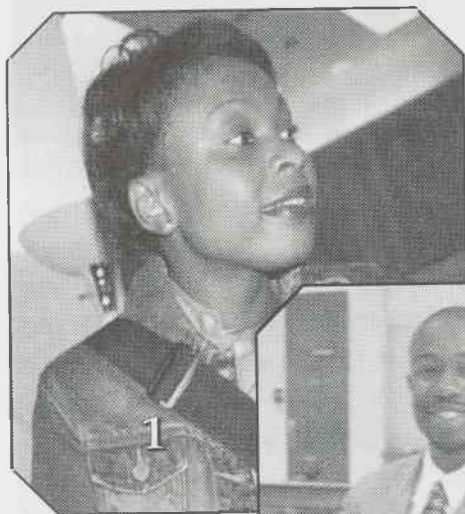
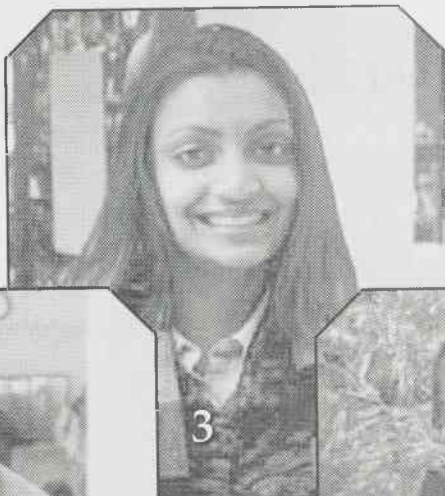

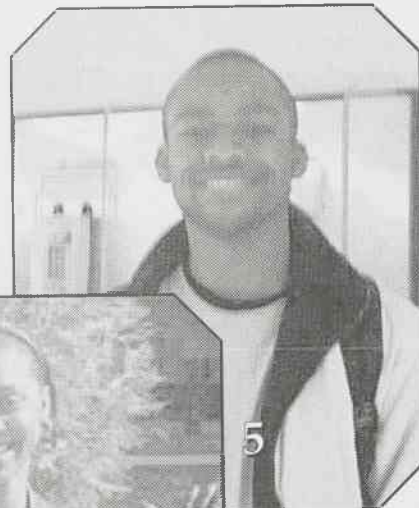
A campus under construction: good or bad?



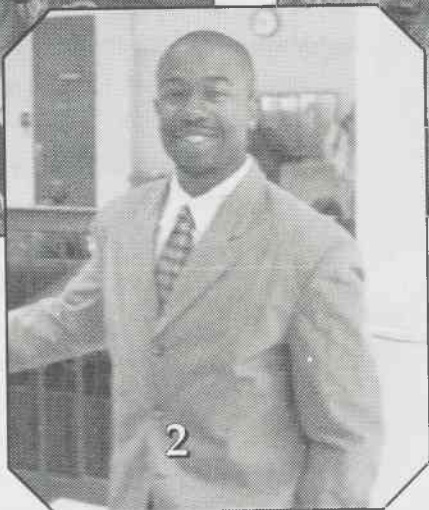

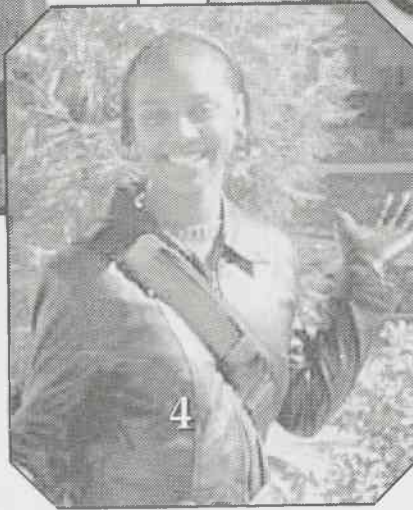
