

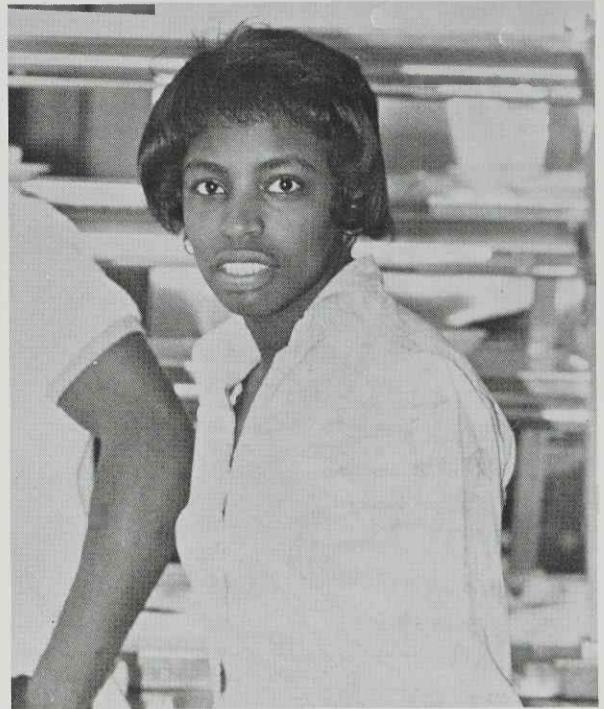
Congratulations To All Seniors!



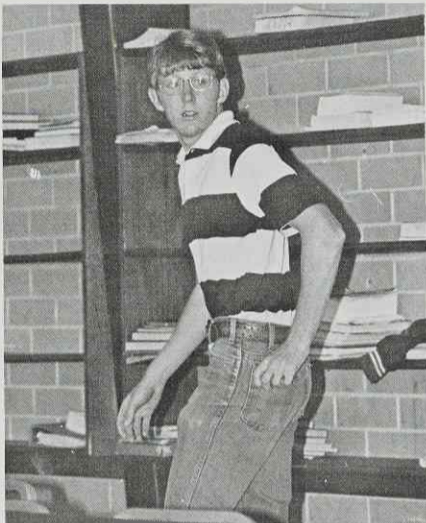
Phil Sheppard may assume a prayerful attitude, but don't let him fool you . . . just ask Connie!

These are the good 'ole days, and to those who will join the ranks of Gardner-Webb alumni next year, The Pilot staff extends a warm wish of good luck.



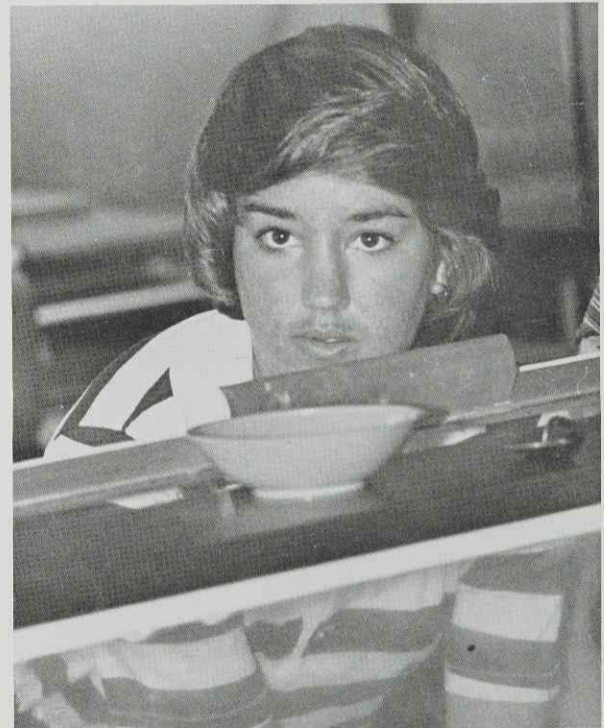
