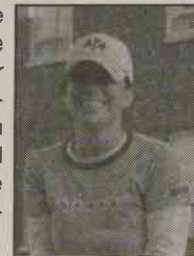
"No, especially for transfer students. Something needs to be done about them having to register two days before classes start [and] everything is full and you can't get any of the classes you want."
