5 diamond bid is practically an unstoppable contract, conceding ly a spade and a heart trick to West. However, let's observe the NT contract for a good lesson about what not to do. 3NT is an sound bid by South, for if North had no club stopper, the hand uld be set back one trick.

Irregular as it may seem, North-South arrived at a 3NT bid. spade king was led by West, who captured two spade tricks from top. South can see only eight tricks from the top, and to secure contract, attempts to steal a heart trick by leading to king er taking the third round of spades. West will not permit such argain and cashes the ace of hearts and the two good spades to at the contract by one.

he proper play of the hand is not to squeeze the heart at trick but instead to attack with diamonds. Employing the squeeze inst West, South is able to place West in discard trouble after


