and oppressed classes; that the history of these class struggles form a series of evolutions in which, nowadays, a stage has been reached where the exploited and opposed class-the proletariat-cannot attain its emancipation from the sway of the exploiting and ruling class-the bourgeoisie-without at the same time, and once and

for all, emancipating society at large from all exploitation, oppression, class distinctions, and class struggles."

David McReynolds, member of War Resister's League:

"Revolutions can occur only after they have occurred. Revolution as we usually use the word means the violent effort to create new institutions to help share power among new social forces. Revolutions do not occur because of revolutionaries, but because of massive social tensions that demand change, combined with a political establishment unwilling or unable to make these changes."

Che Guevara:

"The ultimate and most important revolutionary aspiration is to see man freed from alienation. It is the emphasis on the role of the individual, the actor in this strange and moving drama of the building of socialism, in his two-fold existence as a unique human being and a member of the community."

Luis Cabrera on "The philosophy of the Mexican Revolution":

"A revolution is not always a source of evil and tears, just as fire does not always produce devastation. . . In tropical countries the common way of opening fields to cultivation is to clear them with a great fire that consumes indeed much natural wealth, but which at the same time devours rapidly the jungle, and, by purifying and fertilizing the soil, saves a large amount of work." Eldridge Cleaver, from "Conversations with Eldridge Cleaver":

"Revolution: an armed rebellion with which the poor of America will establish their own dictatorship, without regard to the "democratic rights" of the non-poor."

Faculty On Campaigning

The faculty, meeting Tuesday afternoon, took action on a recommendation from the Faculty Executive Committee concerning political activities and academic responsibilities.

The recommendation, approved by the faculty, stated: "That the Faculty express its interest in both faculty and student participation in the election campaigns this fall and affirm its judgment that, in the context of existing academic regulations, the reading period already scheduled on October 19-20 makes provision for such participation."

Regarding the statement, Dean Davidson noted that "the student ought to take the initiative in making the decisions about participation; for the college to make the decision for the faculty and students is not the best way to do it." He pointed out that as long as a student makes adequate provision for handling any academic work missed outside of the reading period because of political work, the faculty would be expected to cooperate in a students desire to participate in political campaigning. This is the same approach being taken by Duke.
