low income and elderly people in the Lenoir area.

Other hunger action programs explained and demonstrated during the workshop included the legislative impact program of the North Carolina Council of Churches, under the leadership of Council spokesman Collins Kilburn. Catherine Waller of the Charlotte area Fund and Rosemary Mims of Project REACH, a part of the

N.C. Department of Human Resources, demonstrated the usefulness of employing local volunteers in organizing and running food stamp outreach programs.

On the international level demonstrations included a Youth Service Project in Zaire (Congo), and a farming improvement program in Haiti, sponsored by Covenant Presbyterian Church of Charlotte.
