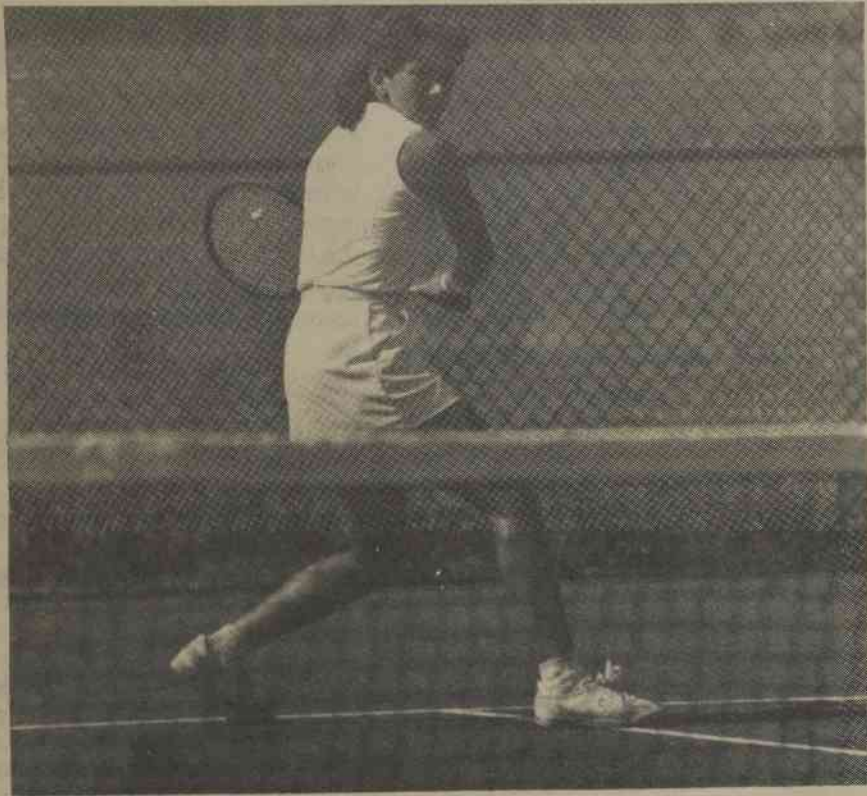
have never been on a tennis team.

mination and improvement since the beginning of the season.

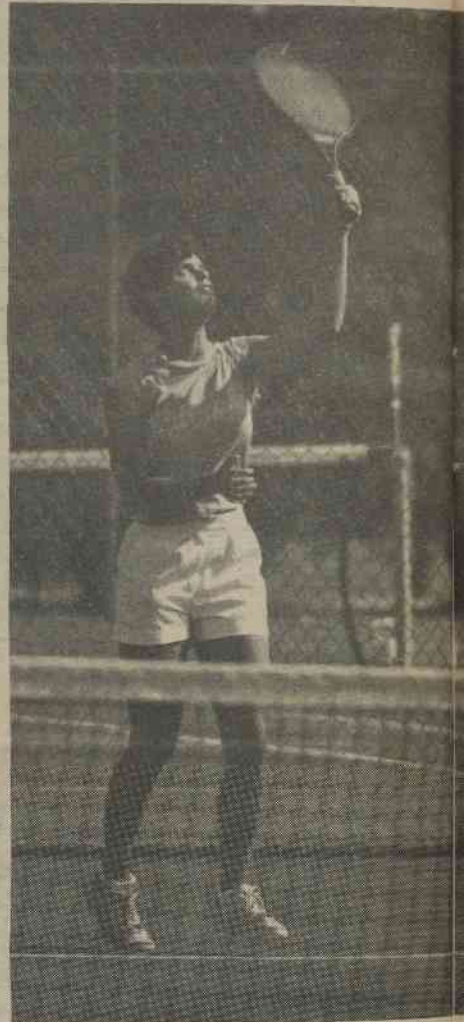
