

When asked about what he wants to accomplish as an educator of future theologians, Dr. Oldenburg replied that he wants to "shape the future leaders of the Church to be faithful to the tradition of God in a culture", that is, to keep the

work of the Church and of God alive within the secular world, not just as a theology.
