

Four different players scored for St. Andrews as the unbeaten Lady Knights soccer team beat Queens College of Charlotte 4-1 Sunday afternoon in the Little Ceasars Invitational Women's Soccer Tournament.

St. Andrews' win gave the Lady Knights the championship trophy by virtue of a better goal differential than Coker College, which also won two games in the four-team tournament. The Lady Knights had 11 goals in two games while Coker had five. Queens finished third and Shenandoah College was fourth. In Sunday's other game, Coker edged Shenandoah College of Winchester, Va., 3-2 in overtime.

Four St. Andrews players were named to the alltournament team, including tournament MVP Joy Feinburg. Other all-tournament selectees from St. Andrews were Adrienne Atkins, Katie Vines and Cathy Feeley.
