Dr. Elder Speaks

Dr. Elder, gave a timely inaugural address related to proposals for dealing with the crises on college campuses. Speaking briefly on some of the causes of campus disorders - social unrest, unfulfilled promises, suppression of creative tendencies, and lack of di-

rection - the retired educator and administrator stated, "Young people of today are keen observers of life around them, and some of them do not like what they see."

"They are thinking about new directions, and in certain instances they are translating their

thoughts into actions," Dr. Elder explained.

Presenting his imaginative proposal, the inaugural speaker said that "arrangements should be made for discussion meetings by means of which students and teachers might exchange
