Yes, it's the "The Compass" and we're back. Take the time to read the pages. You'll see many old and new faces and names.


The staff is a creative group expressing new ideas for the future of "The Compass."

We are fortunate to have a large SGA composed of very qualified students. This academic year should really be rocking.


### Privacy
