

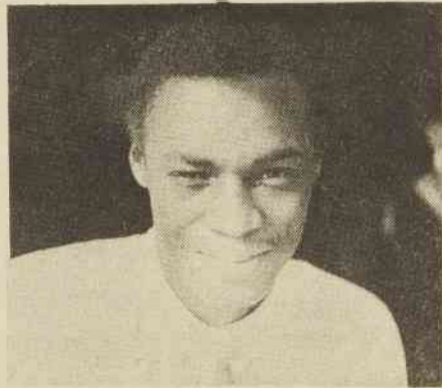
Students Speak Out
