O'Kelly Library is expanding

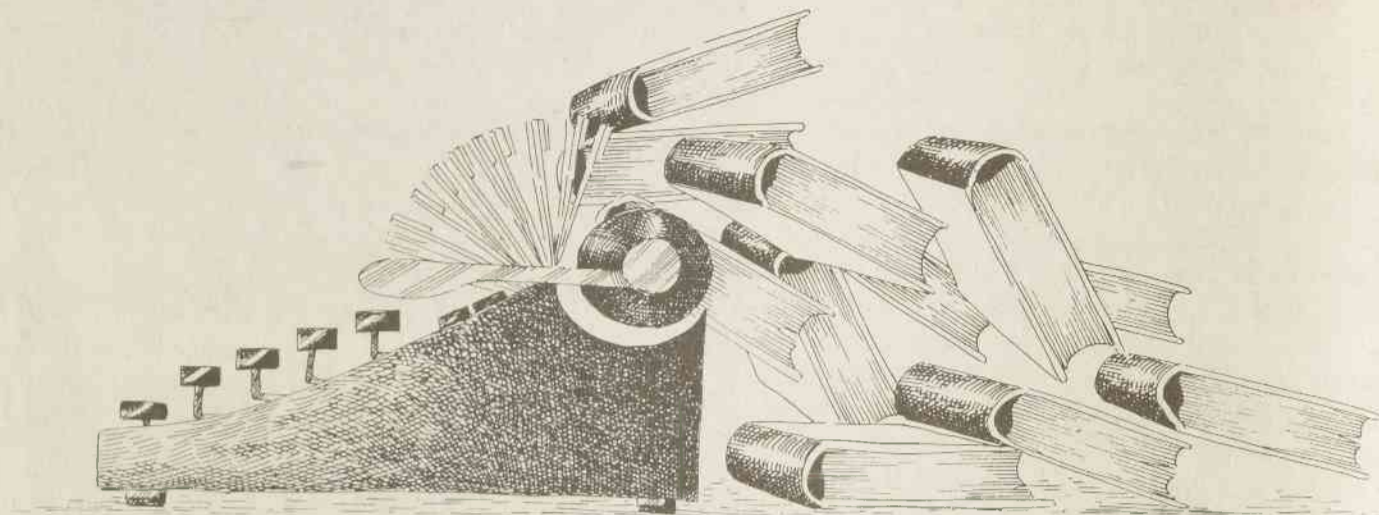
