"I waited until my children were old enough to take care of themselves before I came back. My older children are now old enough to look after the young ones," said Sawyer-Wilson.


She has always been concerned about education for herself and her children. "I taught my two smallest children at home for six years before putting them in the public school system," s he said.


In her spare time Sawyer-Wilson enjoys reading and vacationing with he family whenever she has the time and finances.
