

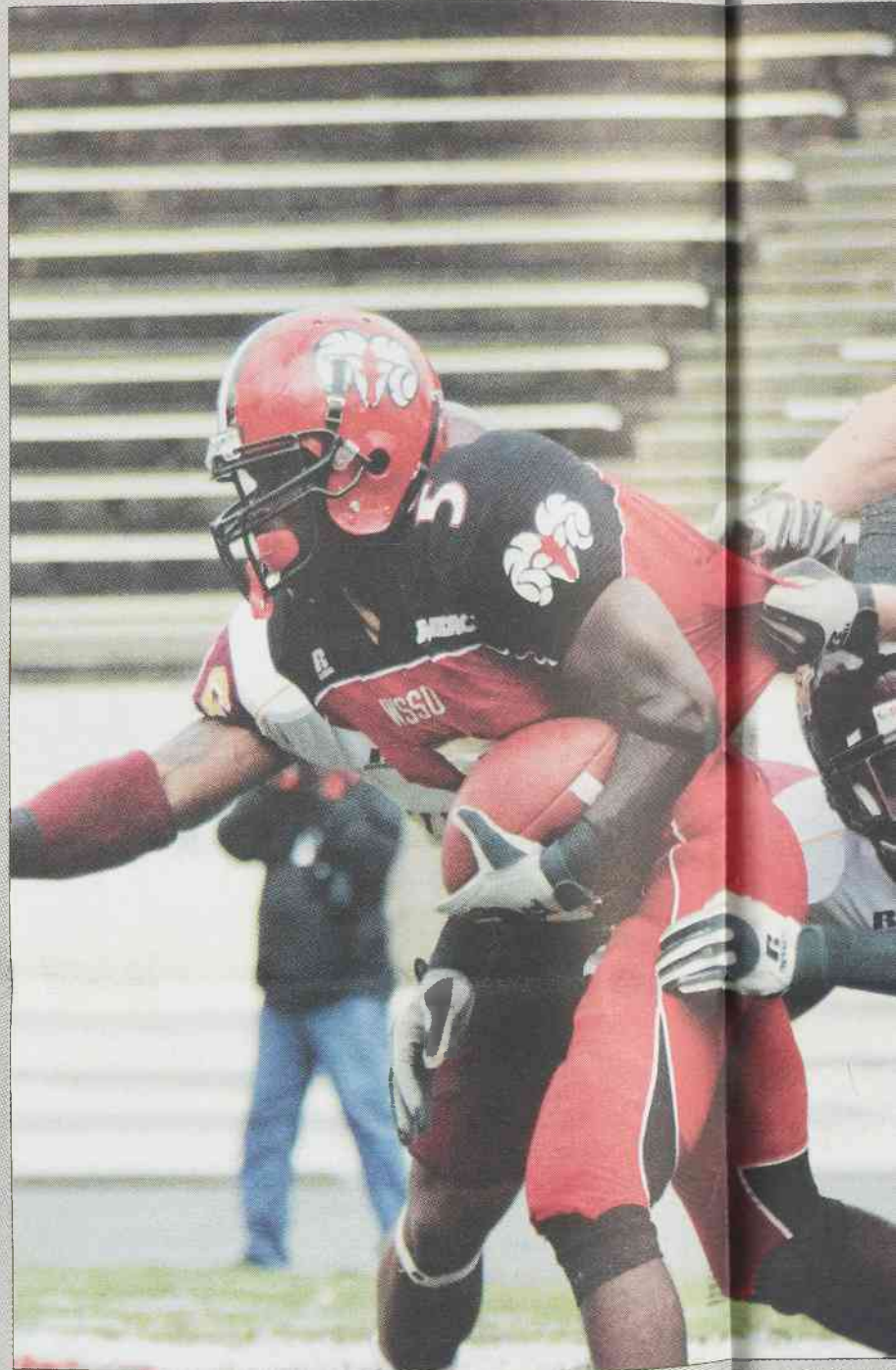
Homecoming F
