The cast members are as follows:

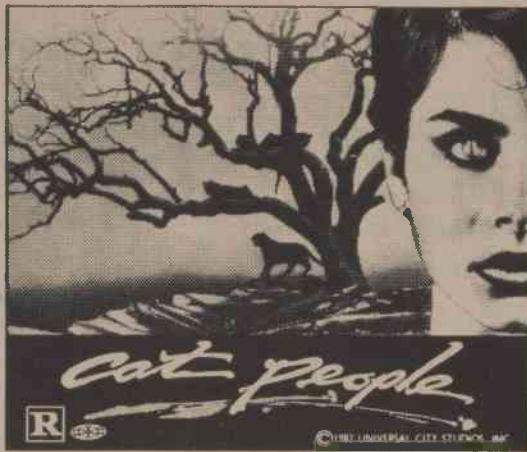

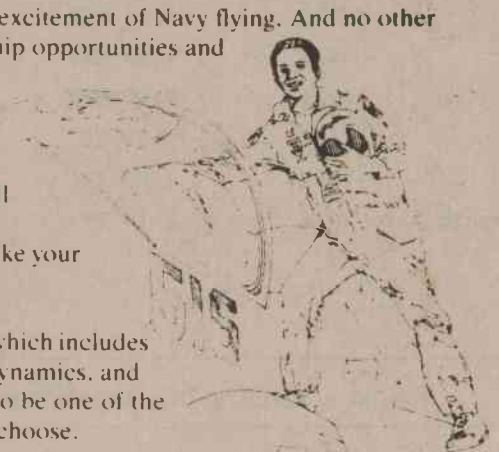
