## MR. HUMPHREYS

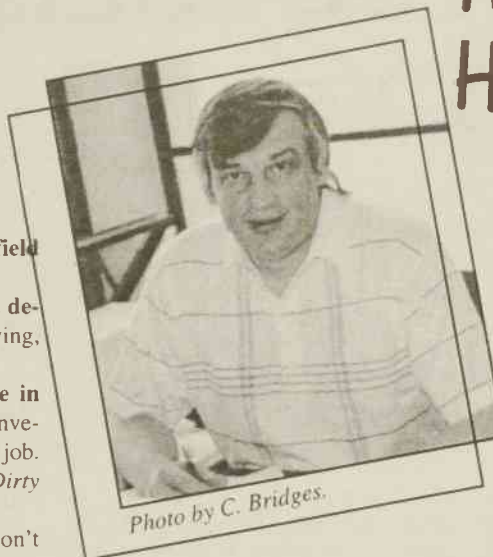
