making use of glass as a camouflaging agent, because it is light in weight, doesn't decay, and is unaffected by fresh or salt water, and will not burn. Fine, flexible glass fibers thinner than a human hair, are being used as the covering or garnishing for the metal-mesh camouflage nets which are used to hide strategic war-production plants and other possible bombing objectives from enemy raiders. The fibers can be painted as often as possible to keep the camouflage design in harmony with seasonal changes in the surrounding countryside. The glass fibers are spread over chickenwire which is used as a net. Since the combination of metal and glass is incombustible, the nets cannot be destroyed by incendiary bombs.
