

COUNCIL (CONT)

- II. That every member of the Community shall maintain full rights to his property and shall respect the property rights of all others.
- III. That every member of the Community shall have his word taken without question and shall trust the word of all others."

The Community Council shall be composed of 4 students, 2 faculty members and 1 staff member. The office of the Dean will publish a list of those students who have a C average, and from this list the faculty will select 8. The student body at large will elect 4. The students will select 4 faculty members from which the faculty will choose 2. The member from the staff shall be appointed by them.

Following Christmas vacation, the Council will be organized more fully and elections held.
