SCA PLANNED

The organization of a Student Christian Association has been approved by the faculty of Wesleyan College. The SCA is a group in which each student of the college may participate and is affiliated with the Inter-faith Council, a committee under the Student Government Association.

As such, the SCA will begin at Wesleyan in fall, 1961, although plans are being completed now. Each denomination on campus with at least six members will form a group, with one representative to the Inter-Faith Council. For each additional twenty-five members, the group will be allowed another representative. In addition to forming the Inter-Faith Council, these representatives will constitute the Religious Life Planning Committee on the campus.

ELECTIONS HELD

To fill the vacancy of the president of the Student Government Association, Vann Massey of Ahoskie was elected by acclamation at a meeting of the student body, February 9, 1961. To fill the offices of Secretary and Vice-President, nominations were made and the election was held the following day. Jack Price of Rocky Mount was elected to the office of Vice-President, while Joan Lamberth of Roxboro was elected Secretary.

Student membership on the Community Council was also elected February 10. Susan Black and Gary Garlow will represent the student body for three semesters, with Betty Anderson and Louis Womble, who will serve for one semester. Dr. C. Edwin Harwood and Dr. Willard Gatewood were chosen to represent the faculty for three and one semesters respectively. Miss Lois Collins, to serve one semester will represent the staff.

Other vacancies in the student government committees were filled by Vann Massey, SGA President. Judy Biggs and Margaret Walters were appointed to serve as co-chairmen of the annual committee. Freddie Jones was named as chairman of the SGA Committee to study student government. Jane Smith was named a new member of the SGA Committee.

Policy and regulations concerning the Community Council was proposed by the Special Committee and approved by the student body at its February 9 meeting.
