The Wesleyan bowlers, on December 2, began their second year of competitive bowling in the Dixie Conference, under the leadership of their new coach, William O. Music, Jr.


Competition will be as last year, the bowlers bowling on their home lanes and the results being sent to a central center where the official league standings are tabulated.




