(Continued from page 1) only fault we can find in the film. Though we cannot rate "The Charge of the Light Brigade" as an excellent film, it is very good as an historic drama, as a psychological study, and as an anti-war film.

19th Century political cartoons (in animated form) delightfully link the major segments of the film together and display Richardson's genius. They were truly one of the highlights of the film.

Two points were brought sharply into focus as we viewed "The Charge of the Light Brigade:"

1.) The romanticized wars of the past, fought by "gentlemen (Christian) soldiers," were merely more horribly mismanaged and senseless than the wars we fight today.

2.) "We learn nothing from history except that we can learn nothing from history."

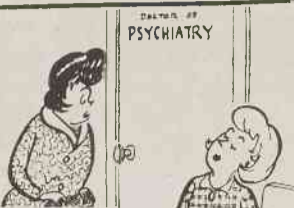
