Library Joined To 'INWATS'

The library at North
 Carolina Wesleyan Col-
 lege has been granted ac-
 cess to the IN-WATS In-
 formation Service of the
 North Carolina State Li-
 brary effective April 1.

Public libraries have
 been using this unique
 service since February,
 1968, and other types of
 libraries have had access
 to it through them. This
 new policy gives the li-
 braries of four-year col-
 leges and universities di-
 rect access to the State
 Library via Inward Wide
 Area Telephone Service
 (IN-WATS). An automa-
 tic answering and record-
 ing device will accept
 calls when the State Li-
 brary is closed.

The principle use col-
 lege and university li-
 braries will make of IN-
 WATS Information Ser-
 vice will be to identify
 location of materials
 prior to requesting them
 through interlibrary loan.
 The State Library will re-
 lay such locations re-
 quests via TWX (Tele-
 typewriter Exchange Ser-
 vice) to the Interlibrary
 Center Union Catalog at

the University of North
 Carolina Library in Cha-
 pel Hill and will call lo-
 cation information re-
 ceived back to the library
 initiating the request.

"This will mean a re-
 duction of at least two
 days in interlibrary loan
 transactions," according
 to Philip Ogilve, State
 Librarian.

"It will make un-
 necessary much ex-
 pensive duplication of
 specialized materials in
 college and universitiy li-
 braries," he adds.

North Carolina State
 Library IN-WATS Infor-
 mation Service is funded
 from Title III of the Li-
 brary Services and Con-
 struction Act. Profes-
 sional librarians receive
 and process all calls
 received- both biblio-
 graphic locations re-
 quests and reference
 questions.

"Public libraries have
 found IN-WATS Informa-
 tion Service quick and
 reliable in these days
 when there is a note of

urgency in every infor-
 mational request," says
 Librarian Alva Stewart.

"College and universi-
 ty libraries should find it
 equally effective," he
 adds.
