C. 97 and U. S. 301 Business near the Rocky Mount Municipal Airport. The other driver was Jimmy Bryant of Battleboro.

Thrown from the bus in the collision, he lost consciousness.

Eric was given aid by Wesleyan students John Roberts and Tom Snyder, who were following the bus.

Stoney Creek Rescue Squad took Eric to Rocky Mount's Parkview Hospital, where, after a delay in order to contact school doctors, treatment was given him. Dean Wilde and Dr. James came to the hospital to confer with police representatives.

He emphasized extra-curricular as well as curricular goals for students, encouraging and urging for all students involvement in campus and community activities.

Dr. Davis directs the Wesleyan Chamber Singers and devised the musical effects for Wesleyan College Theatre's recent

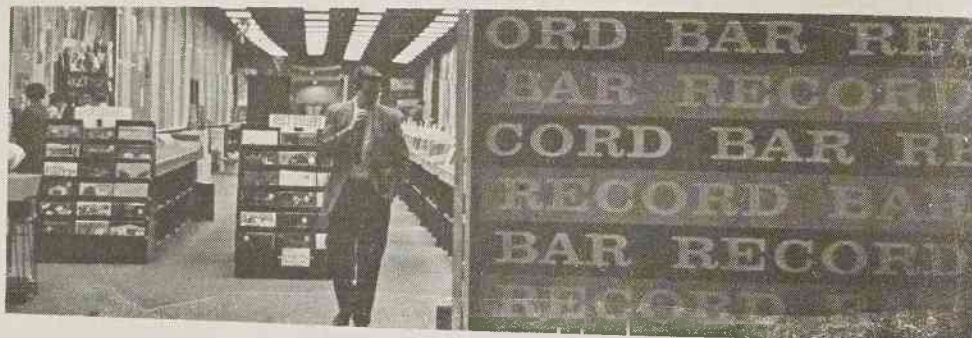
