If I were living under such conditions, I would protest. Being a male member, I am not affected negatively by the rules and can afford to be apathetic about the whole thing.

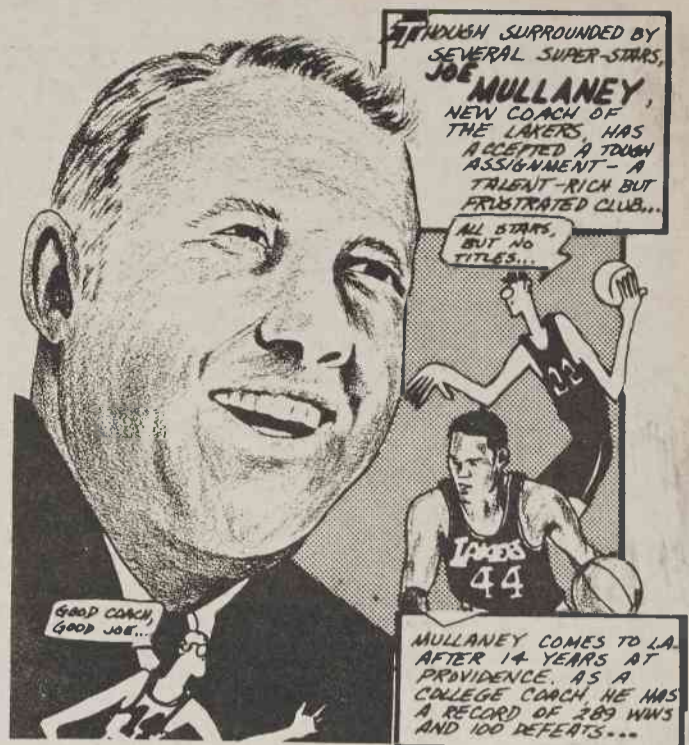

being the minimum age for its use. Commenting upon evidence that constant use of marijuana over a period of twenty years can cause brain deterioration; she stated, "You can show the same thing if you do nothing but eat for twenty years."

No American deaths were reported from Viet Nam for a twenty four period last week. This was the first such period that has occurred since the Viet Nam buildup began in 1965.

According to the latest Harris Poll released last Monday, 70% of the American Public approved President Nixon's latest troop withdrawal of 35,000 troops from Viet Nam. Only 15% opposed the move, with 14% undecided.

Senator William J. Fulbright, Chairman of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee charged Tuesday that the United States Central Intelligence agency has been backing a Clandestine war in Laos without Congressional Knowledge. According to reports following a pro-western army in the northern area of Laos. Several Senators other than Fulbright stated their

concern over the possibility of further American involvement in Laos while at the same time the United States is attempting to reduce actions in Viet Nam.

The Supreme Court unanimously ruled last week that all school districts must operate integrated systems "Now and hereafter." This latest decision alters the previous "all deliberate speed" ruling and requires that the districts and segregation "at once."
