They also expressed a collective wish to stimulate interest in Wesleyan among the area high school students."

This discount will be available to every Nash-Edgecombe student who meets certain criteria. Among these criteria are: the student must officially enroll at Wesleyan as a full time student, be a legal resident of either county, or a graduate of a secondary school located in either of these counties. 
