Congratulations to Steve Embler who won the trophy for the best all around player on the Little League baseball team. Steve is the son of Jean Embler, looper of Plant #1.

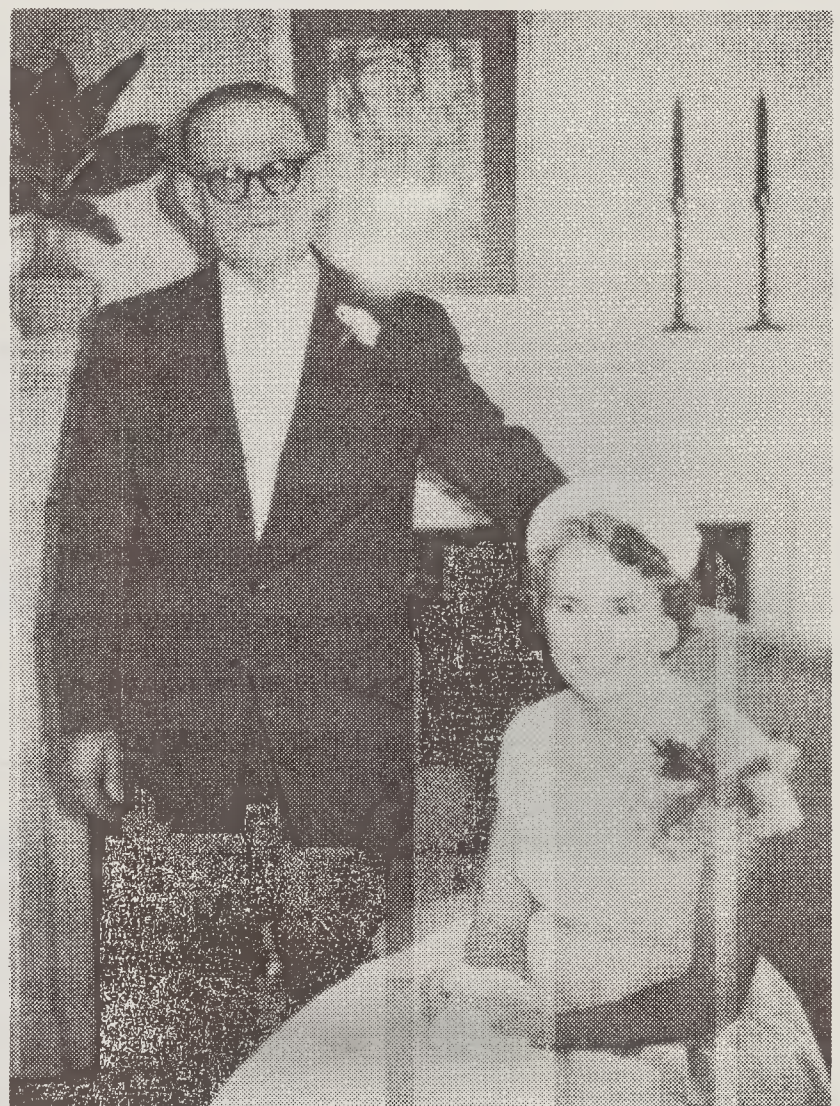
