

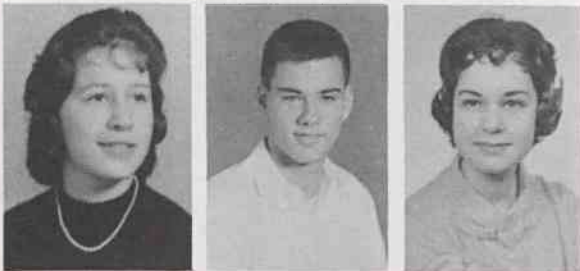

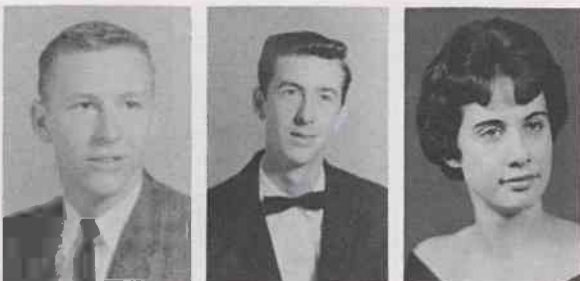
Babette Weber, High Point Senior High School. Daughter of John Weber, vice president, Southern Die Casting and Engineering Company.
