Mrs. Calhoun was one of 609 employees who took advantage of the vaccinations administered in our Kernersville plant by Dr. R. H. Whitaker and in our High Point plants by Dr. Creech. In High Point, there were 441 employees participating and in Kernersville, there were 169.

According to Dr. Creech, the serum used protects against 40 different viruses causing flu and colds. The second vaccination will be given in both plants on November 7. Individuals who did not take the first shot may take the vaccination on November 7 and take the second one later from Drs. Creech and Whitaker, or they may take the second from their family physician. A person getting just one vaccination, according to Dr. Creech, gets 80% as much protection as those getting both doses.

Studies are to be made in our plants to compare the incidence of flu among those who received the vaccina--5- tion and those who did not receive it.
