VACATION PAY DISTRIBUTED

Vacation pay amounting to \$56,596.37 was paid to 1,225 employees of Adams-Millis Corporation on December 14, 1962. Vacation pay is distributed semi-annually, in July and in December.

In order to be eligible for December vacation pay, employees must have completed one year, or more, of continuous service on the previous October 1 and be on the payroll on that date. The amount received is based on individual earnings from the previous April 1 to the previous October 1, those employees with one to five years of continuous service receiving 2% of their earnings and those with five years, or more, of continuous service receiving 4% of their earnings.

More than one-half of the employees have been with the company for five years, or more, and received vacation pay on a 4% basis. The distribution was as follows:
