The High Point Y. W. C. A. offers a program for the care of senior citizens sixty years of age and older. The program provides care for elderly family members who cannot be left alone during working hours, thereby reducing absenteeism for the working members of the family.

The senior citizen care center is open during first-shift hours, Monday through Friday. Noonmeals and snacks are served and transportation can be arranged. A registered nurse is on duty. Cost of this service will be based on the salary and the number of persons in the family.

A varied program, including handicrafts, movies, and trips, is offered for the interest of those senior citizens participating.
