In addition to Pattillo, the following persons will form the institute's faculty: Dr. Mary Townes and Vernon Clark, biology; Dr. E. L. Totten and James R. Butts, chemistry; Dr. Marjorie L. Browne and Dr. Joseph Battle, mathematics.

Summer Training Program

The science training program for high ability secondary school students, to be directed by Dr. Nell Hirschberg of the college's Department of Biology, will accept 30 male and 10 female students. Though it is designed for rising seniors the program will include a few students who graduated from

high school in June. All students will take mathematics, designed to introduce them to new and advanced methods. Each student will also choose an area of specialization (either biology or chemistry) and work, under direction, on individual projects. Class sessions and conference will feature surveys of the fields of biology or chemistry.

Dr. Hirschberg, biology; David Denny, biology; Dr. Norman Padnos, chemistry; and Dr. Elwood Boulware, mathematics, will comprise the faculty.

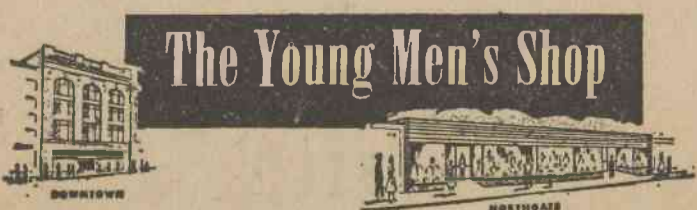
