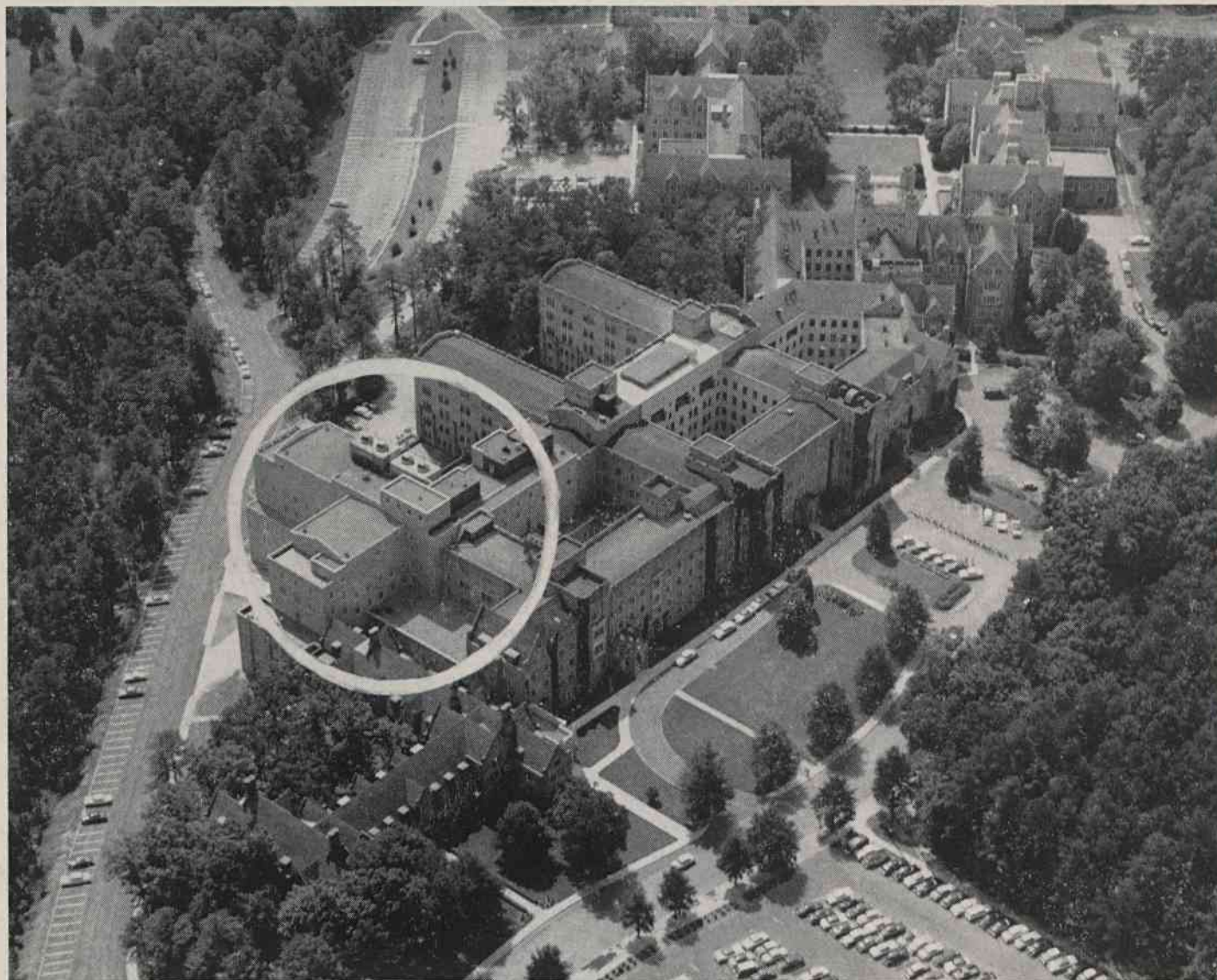

DEDICATION SET FOR FOUNDER'S DAY

Duke Hospital's new multi-million dollar wing will be dedicated in special ceremonies early next month.

The new addition will be formally dedicated on December 11, during the annual Founder's Day celebration for Duke University. Following an address in Page Auditorium at 10:10 a.m. and a luncheon at noon, a ceremony to formally open the wing will be held at the new entrance. Following the service, guests will be conducted through the new wing by members of the Women's Auxiliary

and hospital administration students.

Invitations to the formal opening are being extended to doctors, hospital administrators and other health agencies throughout the state. Members of the committee planning the event are F. Ross Porter, chairman; Dr. Paul Gross, Dr. J. Lamar Callaway and Charles A. Dukes.

Under construction since January, 1955, the new seven-floor addition provides 109 new beds and expanded patient care, teaching and employee facilities.
