

These pictures taken at last month's Disaster Plan drill show hospital staff, police and civil defense workers scurrying to make this the smoothest drill to date.

A student's report to the police department that the roof of Page Auditorium had collapsed resulting in many injuries triggered the start of Disaster Plan B.

Some of the staff had observed a Fort Bragg military disaster drill the previous day and had brought back a supply of gruesomely realistic plastic "injuries" that they applied enthusiastically to the 70 to 80 medical student "casualties."

The first of a series of meetings has been held with police and civil defense officials to evaluate Duke's Disaster Plan. The consensus was that this drill went off very well but that there are still bugs to be worked on before the next drill is held
