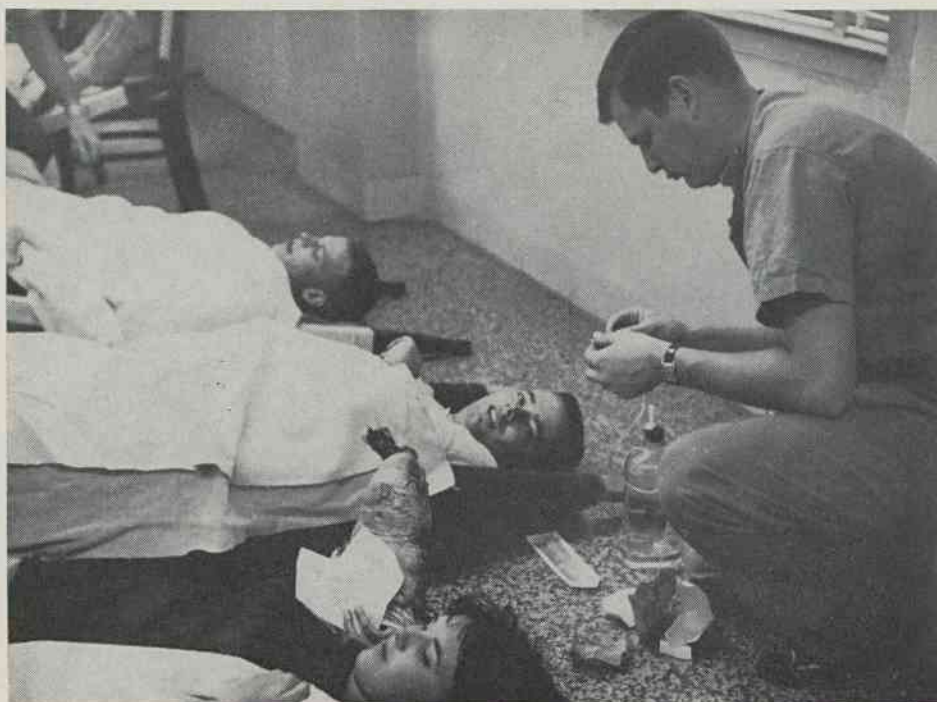




TORNADO MOBILIZES DISASTER TEAM. On May 6 report of a tornado striking the married student housing area put into action the Duke Medical Center's disaster plan. Above, victims are treated at the scene or removed by stretcher and truck to the hospital. One of a series of annual drills which have included a simulated train wreck, plane crash, roof cave-in, and explosion, this exercise was designed, in particular, to test medical decision making by students under disaster conditions.
