### • SORRY TO LOSE . . .

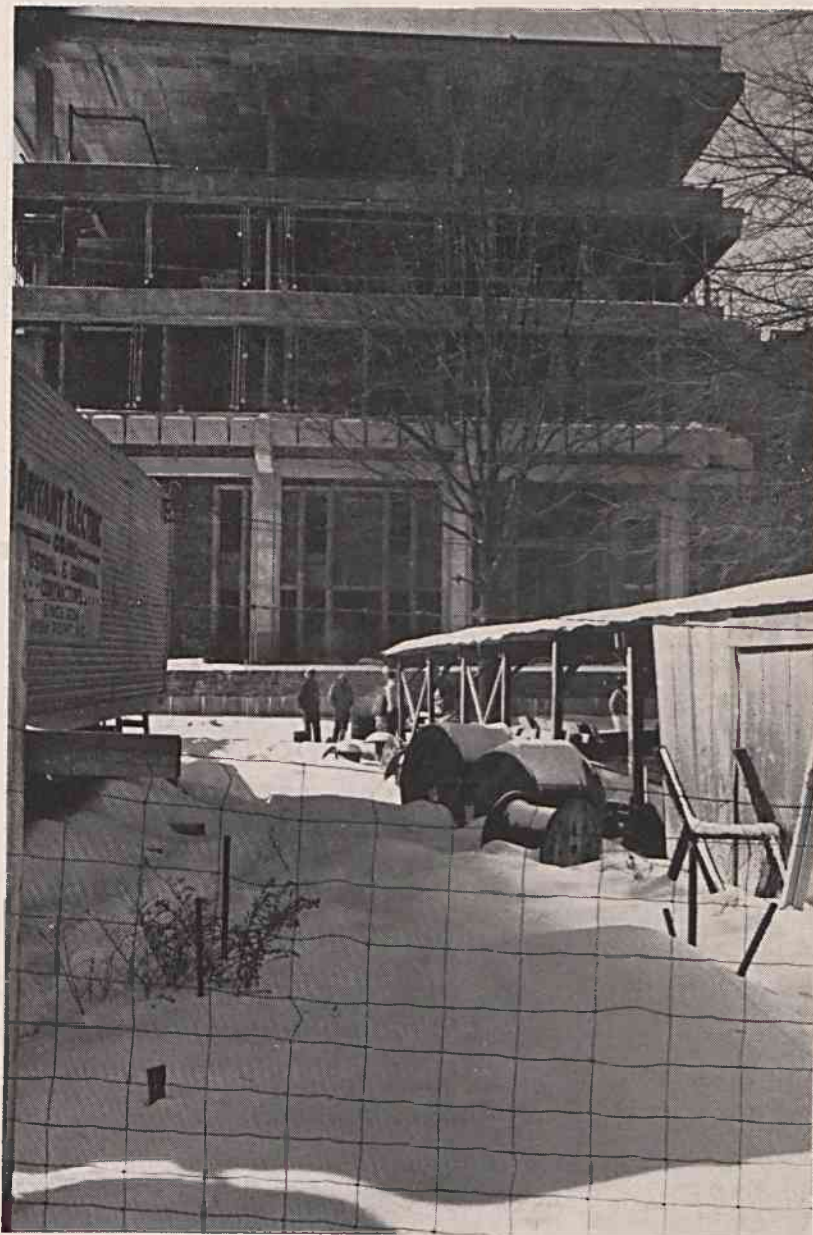
