At this same time last year, *Intercom* published a Christmas letter that was sent out by the Medical Center Chapel Committee suggesting that those persons who usually give support to a favored organization at Christmastime might give some thought to a donation to the Hospital Chapel Fund.

Contributions amounting to about half of the total cost of the religious center have been received to date, and it is now hoped that construction of the new facility can begin during the next year.

Quietness, privacy and compassion are three everyday needs of the patient, his family and his friends. And yet, here at Duke, we have little space to allot to "privacy" and there is much activity that disturbs quietness. Compassion is provided at various levels, but there is no one place where all three needs can be met at one time.

The new religious center, with its chapel, family meditation rooms, pastoral counseling rooms, and lounge for the relatives of the critically ill, will help to fill the pressing need.

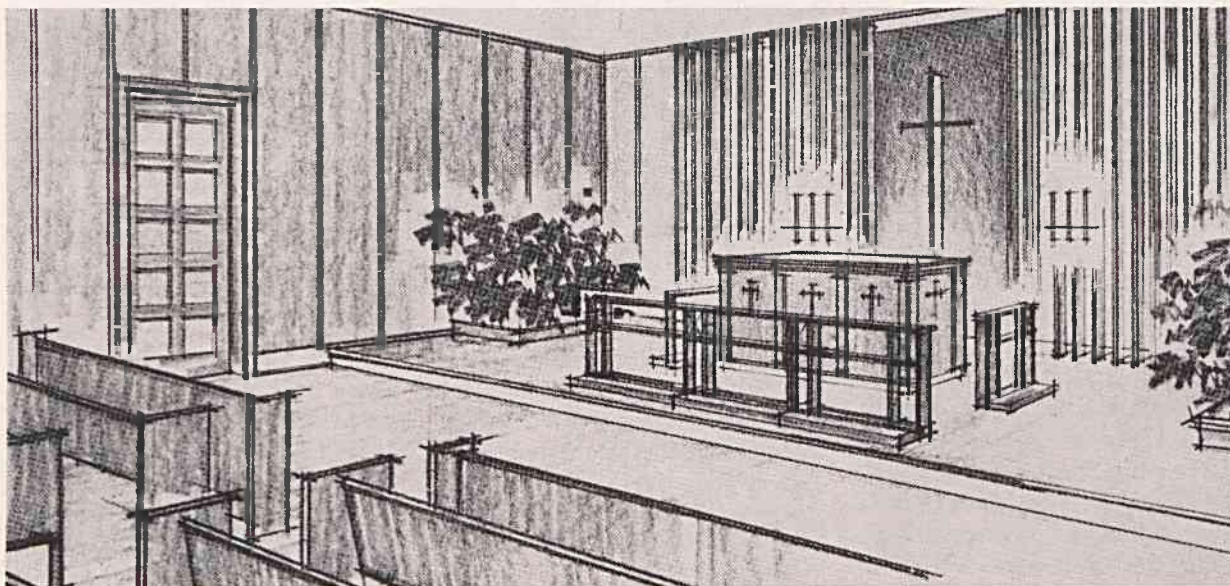
The support that has been given to the project thus far is encouraging, but the remaining half of the necessary funds must be raised before the religious center can be completed.
