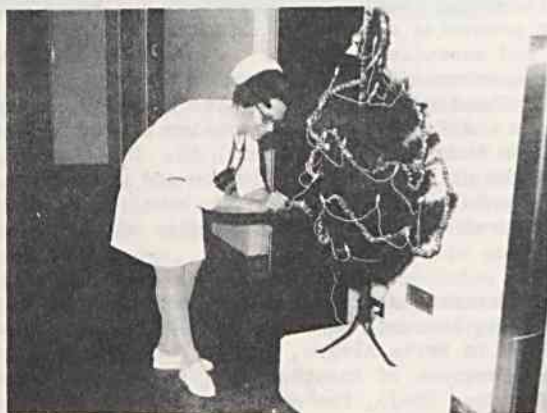

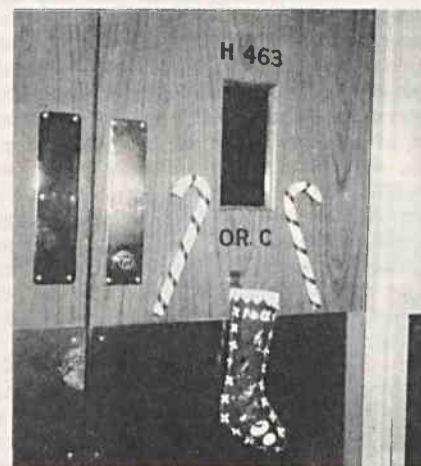
Jackie Leach decorates a Christmas tree on Strudwick Ward for the enjoyment of her patients and fellow workers.
