Win or lose, the women always win. Men have been bemoaning that fact in their homes for generations, but it's just as true on the bowling alley.


At least that's the way the women say it worked out during the second annual "Beat the Boss Night," sponsored Sept. 3 by the Duke Women's Bowling League.
