Donald M. Cheek, assistant business officer of the hospital since November of 1967, has been named to replace Charles D. Herring as hospital business officer.

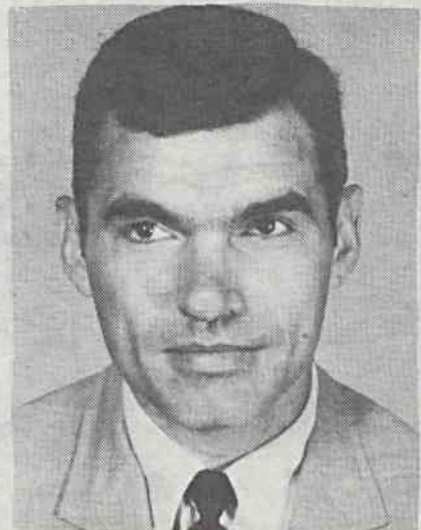
Mr. Herring resigned in March to become business manager of Memorial Mission Hospital in Asheville.
