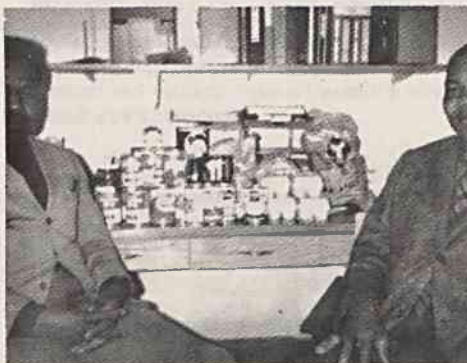

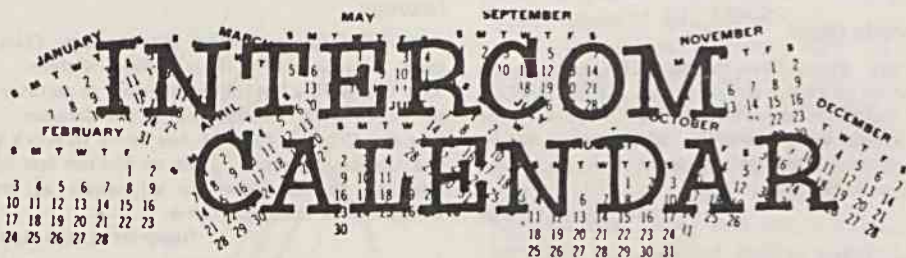
Nurses Selected
