

# Rams foil UNC-W

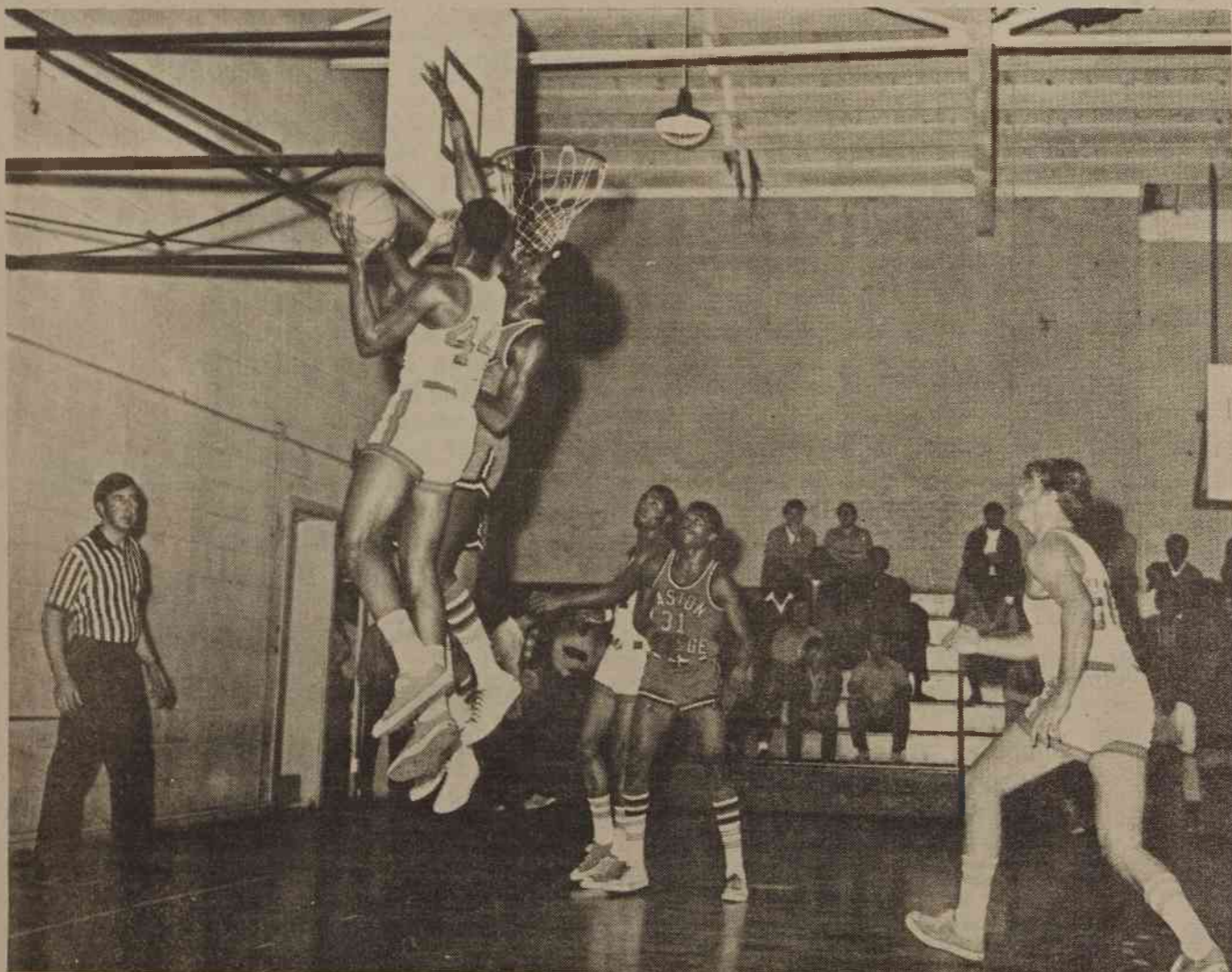


Ram's defense comes down with a rebound in their opening game against the Freshman squad of UNC-Wilmington. The SCC cagers won the game 89-63.

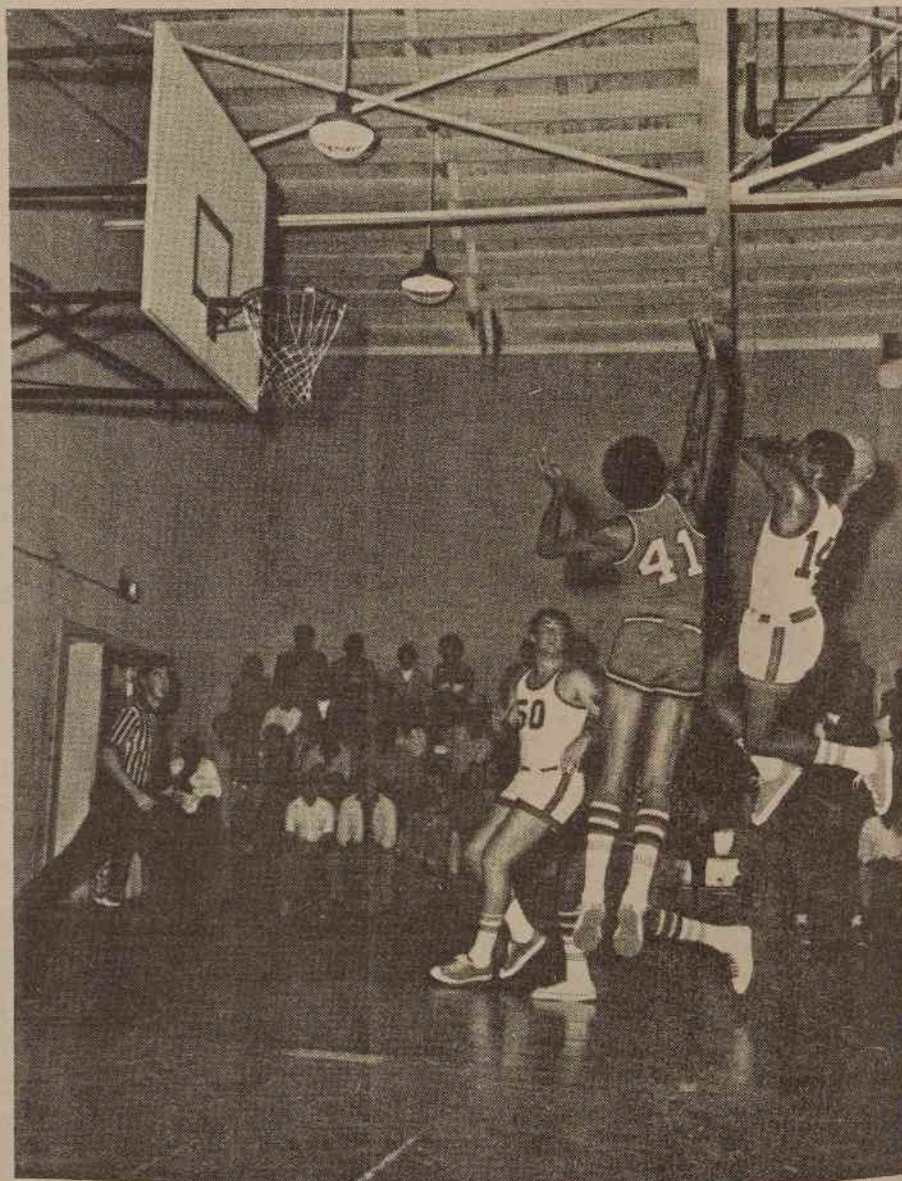
## Rams drop To Gaston
