

THE GREAT SELLOUT

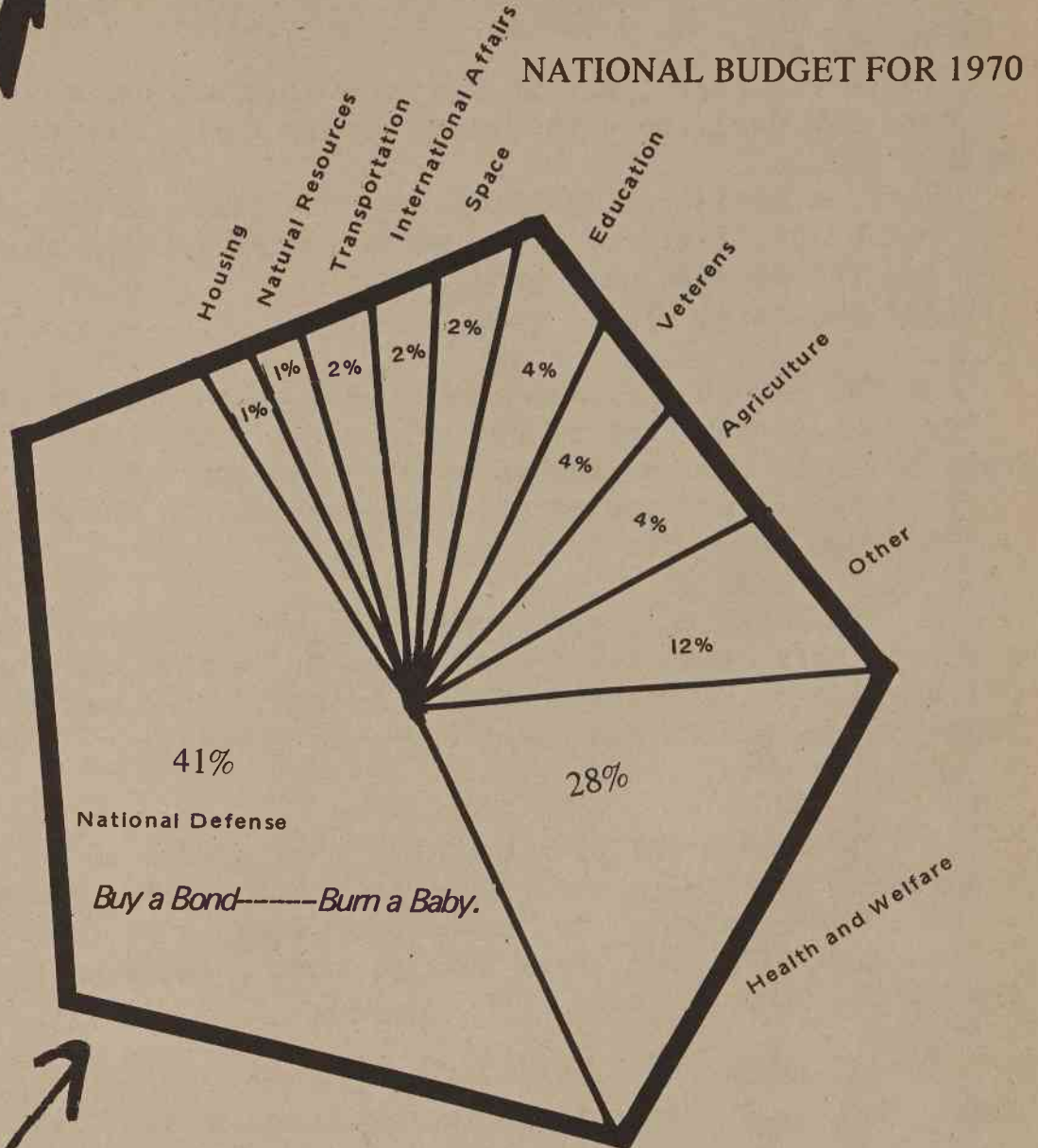

War Tax Resistance

Ways to avoid payment of war taxes:

- (1) Refuse to pay at least \$5 of your taxes
- (2) Hold back the percent that is used for National Defense.
- (3) Refuse to pay federal telephone tax. The tax was revived in 1966 to help pay for war tax. Thousands refuse payment now and have had continued service, the bill goes to the IRS.
- (4) Refuse to pay 10 percent surtax that was created in 1968 to pay for the war.

YOU MAY DEMAND A REFUND

- (1) Get a refund right on your 1040 form. On part V ask for tax credit
- (2) File for a 843 form
- (3) If these don't work go to the Income Tax Board of Appeals - if they don't comply, sue.
- (4) Sue the whole government on the grounds of using taxes for illegal and immoral purposes.

The money you normally pay for war taxes could be put to more peaceful uses such as the Peace Corps, United Nations, any relief funds, ecological causes. For more information write:
