MARK TWAIN SUBJECT OF PSYKALEON STUDY

Selections From Humorist Are Varied
by Story and Music—Short
Play Is Given.

An unusually interesting program was rendered by the Psykaleon Society Monday evening in the Girls' Gym.

The following program was rendered: First, the Biography of Mark Twain by Miss Bessie Hudson. The program for the evening consisted of selections from the works of Mark Twain, therefore, it was very fitting that his life should be given first.

Next Miss Myrtle Somers gave a very good paper on "What Critics say of Mark Twain." This consisted chiefly of criticism by Brander Matthews, an authority on English literature.

Miss Frances Hook read in a very pleasing manner, "The Invalid's Story." This story was unusually humorous and the way in which it was given was well adapted to the general tone.

Miss Mary Lee Foster then gave a vocal solo, "Dawn Lights and Birds' Song," accompanied by Miss Barrett. Miss Foster's voice is sweet, full and strong and her solos are always enjoyed.

The program was varied and made especially interesting by the impersonation of Tom Sawyer and Huck Finn by Miss Foye Young and Mrs. C. M. Cannon. They chose a very interesting selection from Mark Twain's "Huckleberry" and played Tom and Huck to perfection.

Miss Rose Howell read some humorous selections from Mark Twain's "Innocence Abroad." In two of Mark Twain's jokes, Miss Howell showed the rich, quick wit of the humorist and supplemented by giving these jokes in her own amusing way.

The last number of the program was "Traveling With a Reformer," by Mark Twain, read by Miss Violet McCollum, in a very pleasing manner.

100 R. R. Cars Will Bring Giant Circus

Ringling Bros. and Barnum & Bailey
Add Entire Shipload of Big, New
European Features.

Arriving aboard 100 double-length railroad cars forming trains more than one and one-third miles long, and made even greater than in 1922 by the addition of many big, new foreign acts, Ringling Brothers and Barnum & Bailey Combined will exhibit at Durham Thursday, November 1.

Those who read the daily papers or who keep in touch with the movie news-reels need not be reminded of the shipload of acts and animals recently imported by the Greatest Show on Earth. The remarkable cargo included two companies of baby elephants which are now joined with the 40 adults of the mammoth herd. There were also 100 more performing horses accompanied by Europe's greatest trainer, and many wild animals, some of which have been added to the scores upon scores of trained jungle beasts, while others have become part of the marvelous menagerie.

More than a million persons saw the mammoth new circus of 1923 during the weeks that it exhibited in Madison Square Garden, New York. Now this marvelous exhibition is touring the country aboard five great trains. It is a third bigger than the Ringling Brothers and Barnum & Bailey show of last season. It is ten times larger than any other circus now on tour.

Big as is this wonder circus of 1923—with its more than thirty trained wild animal displays in steel arenas, fully 200 wonderfully schooled horses, 700 men and women performers, 100 clowns, and scores of features—the price of admission is no more than before. And though the trained animal numbers and the immense horse show were circuses in themselves while touring Europe, they are not offered as separate attractions by the Ringling Brothers and Barnum & Bailey combined shows. Instead all are on one gigantic program. Everything is in one mammoth main tent. One ticket admits to all these and to the tremendous double menagerie. There are more than 1,000 animals in the zoo of this circus and these include entire families of hippopotami and giraffes. Another remarkable zoological feature is an armored rhinoceros, the only one known to exist and alone worth \$50,000.
