twenty-eight music studios and practice rooms. The Carlton Library building was completed and dedicated in the early fall, Dr. Louis R. Wilson, librarian of the University of North Carolina, making the principal address of the occasion. This building is given over entirely to library purposes. The stack room is built as a fire-proof vault and will accommodate 100,000 volumes. The second and third floors are given over to periodical and storage rooms and seminars. The Duke Science building, which houses all the science laboratories was put in use in October.

Within the next couple of weeks the Christian Education building, which will house all the social and religious activities of the college and the community, will be completed. The finishing touches are now being put on this building, and the furniture will soon be ready for installation. This Christian Education building is unique, it being the only building of its kind on any college campus in the United States. It is a laboratory for the Department of Christian Education of the college, having provisions for a completely graded Sunday School, Junior Church, Week Day Religious Instruction, Daily Vacation Bible School, Boy Scouts, Camp Fire Girls, etc.

Only new equipment of the best grade that could be secured has gone into these buildings. The music and auditorium building is equipped with a four manual Skinner pipe organ, an Eastey two-manual practice organ, Mason and Hamlin and Kimball grands and uprights. The Southern School Supply Co., has supplied all the seating, the Kewaunee and Peterson people, all the laboratory furniture; the Leonard Peterson and Sneed & Co., the library and stack furniture and equipment.

Elon's growth has been phenomenal in the history of North Carolina colleges. Within a little more than a year she has more than doubled the physical equipment. The fire in January, 1923, took the heart of the institution, but less than two years later the whole college has been built anew on a scale five times greater than the old. With these added facilities Elon is one of the best equipped small colleges in the South, affording many opportunities that could not be secured elsewhere.

Nor has the other interests of the college been neglected in the activities of building. Several new departments have been added to the academic studies, and all the old curriculum enlarged and expanded. The endowment of the college has constantly increased, and shows a very substantial gain since the fire, running into hundreds of thousands of dollars. The college is ever reaching out to new and broader fields. The percentage of increase in the student body has this year been larger than at any time in the history of the college.

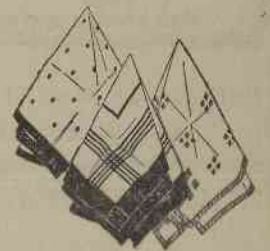

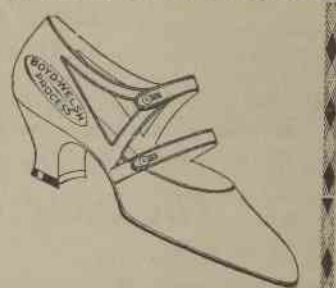


