The Tech offense began to function and soon after the period opened Johnson caged the leather to tie the score after Correll and Dickens had rung in a brace of markers. Elon then ran its score to 18 by a field and two foul shots by Caddell, but at this point State gradually drew away and were never headed.

Harry Brown, Tech center, with 11 opoints, was the leading scorer on the floor. Dickens and Johnson also starred for the Techs. The work of Newman and Byrd featured for Elon.
