

Oil Formed by Fish

Two government scientists, Dr. E. O. Ulrich of the geological survey and Dr. R. S. Bassler of the National museum, have published a book on the microscopic toothlike fossils called condodonts. The researches in connection with the work are believed to have considerable industrial value, particularly to the petroleum industry. Scientists now think that the flesh of Paleozoic fishes contributed largely toward the formation of petroleum. The teeth enable geologists to determine the age of the various strata of rock structure. As a result it is possible to determine in a general way the position of oil pools.-Pathfinder Magazine.
