

Tennis Team Will Invade Northern Territory With Tour Opening Next Week

Opening with an appearance at Easton, Pa., Coach "Rusty" Jones and his Elon college tennis team, after completing a highly successful season so far this year, will embark on an extended northern trip next week with 12 matches on the slate.

The Elon netmen will be in Easton Monday of next week for the first tilt of the northern journey to match against Lafayette college, of Easton, Pa. Following the match with the Easton club, the Christian netters will take on St. John's University at Brooklyn, Tuesday; then meet the University of Pennsylvania racket slingers in a match at Philadelphia, Wednesday; face the Army tennis club at West Point, Thursday; take on St. John's college at Annapolis, Md., Friday; and then close the week with a match again William and Mary, Norfolk Norfolk division, Saturday at Norfolk in a return engagement. The

tour will continue over into the following week and the tennis men will return for a match at Elon against Furman May 11.

At the time this was written Coach Jones's racket slingers had just rung up their eighth consecutive victory of the season with a second win over the High Point netmen in a match on the local

courts, gaining a 9 to 0 victory. Last week saw the locals capture four straight victories, the Elon club trimming Appalachian here Tuesday, High Point College at High Point, Wednesday; Guilford at Guilford Friday, and then close the week with a victory over William and Mary, Norfolk division, Saturday. The first three matches were North State conference victories. The second Guilford victory was chalked up here Monday of this week.

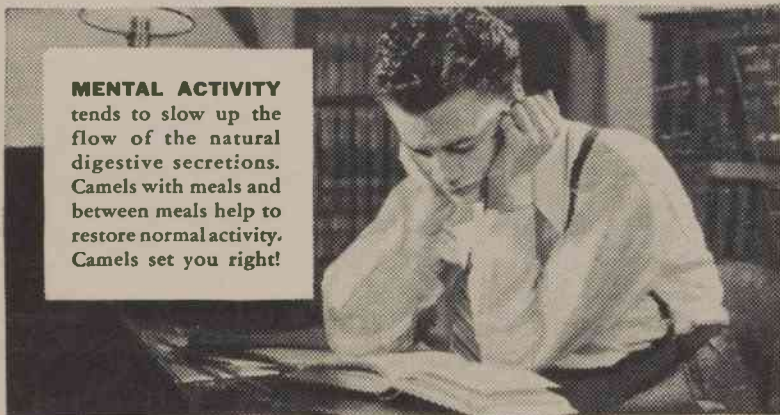

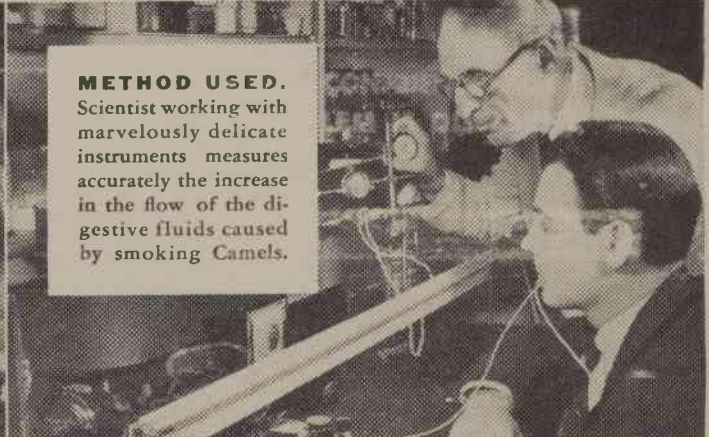
