

Elon Theatre Showing "In Old Chicago" This Week-end

"Captains Courageous" Starring Freddy Bartholomew, Spencer Tracy, Lionel Barrymore, and Melvin Douglas to Play Next Week-end.

After a brief period of "indisposition" Elon movies are once more bringing to their audiences motion pictures that are outstanding. Tonight, one of the truly great Hollywood products is being shown. "In Old Chicago" will grace the silver screen, portraying vividly the events leading up to and including the great Chicago fire.

Alice Faye, Don Ameche and Tyrone Power have stellar roles in this picture, and all three portray their characters with commendable skill. The sequences depicting the tragedy of burning Chicago are unusually effective, showing the stampeding cattle, the dynamiting of buildings, and the flight of Chicago's inhabitants.

A technicolor Travelogue and other brief features are also included on this program.

On Friday and Saturday evenings, November 4 and 5, the Elon Theatre will present "Captains Courageous", starring Freddy Bartholomew, Spencer Tracy, Lionel Barrymore, and Melvin Douglas. Taken from the book by Rudyard Kipling, this picture is to the sea what "The Good Earth" is to the land. Magnificent in production values and in its photography is this story of the Gloucester cod fisheries and the cruise of the two-masted schooner, "We're Here," to the Banks of Newfoundland. It tells the simple story of a rich man's son who falls overboard from his father's yacht off the Grand Banks and is rescued by a Portuguese sailor. Three months on a fishing schooner with men who are close to the realities of life work a transformation in a boy who had gauged everything by its money value.

Mr. Tracy's acting is a gem of effortless simplicity and spiritual understanding, but everyone in the cast gives an admirable performance. As a background to the absorbing story is the cruise of the schooner, stormy sea, fog and the hazards of fishermen, the exciting race with the rival, "Jennie Cushman," all presented with splendid photography and recording.

Kryl Symphony Presented Program Here Last Thursday

Beautiful Selection of Classical Music Was on The Program.

Elon College was fortunate in being enabled to play host to the Kryl Symphony Orchestra last Thursday. This nationally famous orchestra came to the campus to present an outstanding program for the students, and for out-of-town visitors.

In addition to the orchestra, four soloists were included on the program. Dorothy Dickerson, popular Coloratura Soprano, Barbara Le Brun, harpist, Florian Zambach, violinist, and Burtis Preston, Baritone, accompanied the orchestra in an outstanding program of musical selections. Miss Dickerson sang the famous aria, "Una Voce Doco Fa" from Rossini's comic opera, "Barber of Seville". Among the orchestra selections were the overture to the comic opera "The Bartered Bride," by Smetana, "Hungarian Dance No. 6," by Brahms, "Slovakian Dance No. 1" by Dvorak, and "Concert Waltz," by Strauss. The last number was the prelude to the famous opera "Die Meistersinger" by Richard Wagner.

An extensive advertising campaign was carried on previous to this program. The Student Christian Association's Junior and Senior "Y" Cabinets were in charge of the sale of tickets. According to Prof. Pratt's announcement, this was the first time that a full symphony orchestra had appeared in Alamance County, and certainly no symphony orchestra can be heard often for so small a charge.

Methodist Pageant By Messick Gets Praise
